

Class V Driver Training LDC 35 Funding Information

For clarification regarding the delivery of LDC Class V Driver Training 35, LDCs are authorized to permit school authorities to provide instruction, assessment, and supervision in meeting an identified student need. Completion of the Class V Driver Training 35 LDC by reviewing a student's receipt and certificate of completion from a driving school is not an acceptable practice.

As such, course completions submitted for Class V Driver Training 35 will only be funded when the school has demonstrated the commitment to provide instruction by a certificated teacher. If your school authority is only using a driving school to deliver this course, please set the funding requested category to "No" when submitting your term two course completions in Provincial Approach to Student Information (PASI). Students will still receive the credits for the course for the 2015/2016 school year.

We look forward to your attention in ensuring the delivery of instruction supports high quality learning and enables the continuation of LDCs, including Class V Driver Training 35. During the 2016/2017 school year we will continue to monitor the implementation of LDCs including the requirement for instruction provided by certificated teachers.
